1 Cripplegate Park WR2 5BA

Cripplegate Park is located to the west of the city on New Road, opposite the County Cricket ground. The park has a diverse range of features, including a formal arrangement of flower beds, shrub rows, annual bedding, mature trees and open space grassed areas, set out in a traditional style. There are also a children's play area, tennis courts and bowling greens.

2 Fort Royal Park WR5 2DJ

Fort Royal Park is located south-east of Worcester, with the main entrance being on Wylds Lane. Fort Royal Park is of huge historical significance to the city, as one of the sites of the 1651 Battle of Worcester, the final battle of the English Civil War.

3 Gheluvelt Park WR1 3EY

Pedestrian entrances are on Barbourne Road, Lavender Road, Tower Road, Waterworks Road and Barbourne Lane. Gheluvelt Park is a memorial park built in honour of those lost in the First World War. It straddles Barbourne Brook and has two distinct areas - a formal park to the east, and an informal area managed for wildlife conservation to the west, next to the River Severn. Within the park is the Pump House Environment Centre which has a dog-friendly café.

4 Riverside Loop South

Start the walk on the riverside path by the Cathedral and head south away from the city. Cross the river at the new footbridge and head back on the west side to the City Centre bridge. Approx 2 miles.

5 Riverside North

Start walk on Hylton Road on the west side of Sabrina Bridge. A little to the north after the larger path ends, take the riverside footpath. The next bridge is about eight miles, so consider turning back at some point!

6 Pitchcroft Racecourse WR1 3EJ

Apart from race days, the racecourse is open to the public and has a wide tarmac path all the way round. It follows the river on one side. Two mile circuit.

7 Canal Walk

The Worcester to Birmingham Canal is to the east side of the City Centre. It's easy to join at The Commandery WR1 2HU. It can also be accessed from Lowesmoor Wharf or Diglis Basin.

8 Worcester Woods Country Park WR5 2QX

Wildwood Drive. About two miles drive to the east of Worcester close to the main hospital. Café, playground and extensive walks through the woods. Paths can be muddy after rain. Free parking and admission.
